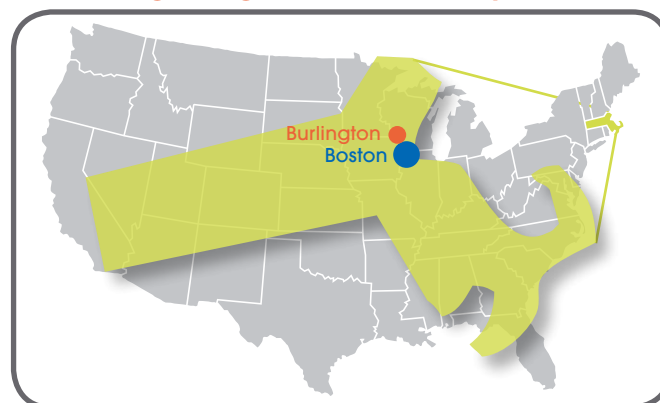
School Profile
